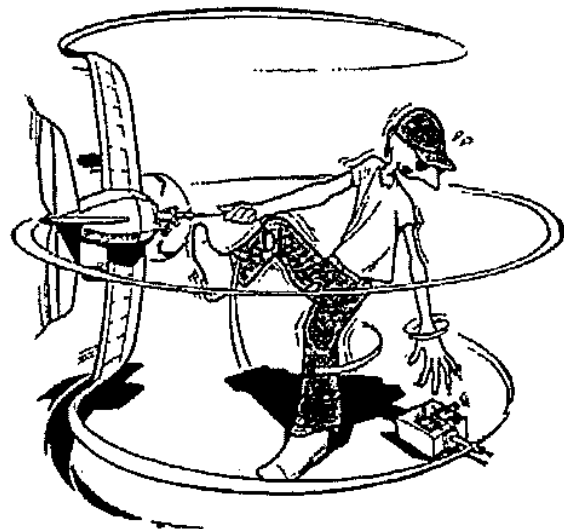

NEW BYLAW: MAKE YOUR VOTE

YOU CAN VOTE ONLINE AT THE CLUB WEBSITE OR AT THE NEXT MEETING

Whenever a club vote is deemed necessary by the board to require the entire club participation (e.g. large expenditures, bylaw changes etc.) voting shall be conducted by a live vote as well as when feasible an electronic vote conducted over the internet. Club members may vote either in person or electronically, if a club member votes electronically that is their final vote and cannot be changed either electronically or by in person vote.
