# SCALE FLY IN Saturday JUNE 24

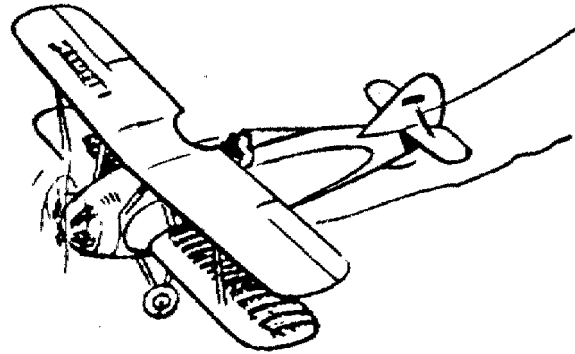

This month the club is going to be hosting an official workshop for the US Scale Masters organization. This event is being put on for a couple of reasons. First, to add benefit to the club and enrich your experience, secondly to introduce scale competition to those that might not otherwise be exposed to it and second, to gauge the interest of scale in the club. If there seems to be interest the club can move on to hosting a USSM qualifying event next year for the national scale masters competition. So if you have any plane that is based off of an airplane that exists in full scale, you can participate. There have been a number of emails about this event and getting ready to compete. I will quickly go over the need to know.

- 1) Get your plane together, remember even foam qualifies, in sport class you only need a picture proving that your airplane existed

- 2) Practice your flight sequence with a friend that will be your spotter. A complete flight sequence guide was sent out a few weeks ago to give ideas of what need to have in your flight sequence. You need to practice with a spotter because they will be your eyes and ears in the sky, and they will be telling you what maneuver comes up next in your sequence.

- 3) Come, learn, and enjoy. The club has worked hard to put on a fun event, come out and enjoy it!

Remember that there is a \$10 landing fee to fly that day, food is going to be sold, and a pretty good raffle will be there including a spectrum radio, Goldberg cub kit, and an ARF as well as gift cards! Hope to see you there.
