
## 2017 SCALE WORKSHOP / FLY-IN EVENT: A SUCCESS

On Saturday June 24, the club held its first Scale Workshop / Fly-in Event. It was a success without question! We had 20 pilots some of which were from surrounding local clubs. We also had a sizable number of spectators who wanted to see what it was all about and to enjoy the day with their friends. For me it was interesting to go to the workshop to hear about the 'scale' part of our hobby. It was 'my introduction' and it was well worth the time and effort spent. Curtis Kitteringham, Interim National Chairman from US Scale Masters Association, did an excellent job of explaining the requirements, trials and tribulations of scale flying and building. Later in the morning there was a scale flight demonstration for all to see which included a real-time critique of the pilot's flying ability and what judges would be looking and judging for during actual competition. Besides general flying we also had three awards that were given out to those who entered their airplane in the judging portion of the event. Pat Schreffler won both the Top Civilian and People's Choice awards for his kit built 1/3 CUB while John Raymond won Top Military for his Hellcat ARF.
