## HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

Some helpful hints to live and fly by when at the field.

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules. Accidents happen but we don't have to give them more of an opportunity than needed.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.
- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers or if needed take it home with you.
- Bring a fire extinguisher and first aid kit to the field as an added precaution. We fly with combustible materials (gas, glow fuel, and batteries) that can cause fires and injuries. Not to mention propellers that can cut. Fly safe and be safe!
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful!
