HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

At CCF safety is our #1 priority, followed closely by having fun... ...and we all know it's no fun when someone gets hurt.

Flying Hours: 8:30a – Dusk

CCF Field Rules



- You must wear your CCF badge when flying.
 Your fire extinguisher must be out and at the ready before flying.
- · All pilots must stand in the designated pilots areas while flying.
- All spectators must stand behind the safety fences.
- Be mindful of your Prop or Jet Blast (especially fuel powered aircraft)
- No "hands off" taxing in the pit area.
- Communicate: "Takeoff", "Landing", "Low Pass", "On the field", etc.
- · Absolutely no flying over the motocross tracks when in use.
- · No flying inside of the double yellow Line.
- If you need a solo flight, or have any other special request, JUST ASK!
- · No smoking on the flight line or in the pit area.
- No driving on the runway, pits, helipad or any of the other paved areas.
- Be respectful and courteous to our fellow members and the public.




CCF is focused on low stress fun and friendly mentorship, Take advantage!


