

If you would like to run for office or you would like to nominate someone for office please write their name(s) on the ballot before submitting.

Finally, since the year is almost over this subject is of concern, those that have not yet donated your annual \$50 donation to the slurry fund please do so now. Of the 65 or so current members, 6 members have actually donated to the fund in 2020. That's terrible! Slurry is by far the biggest expense our club endures. We are making progress with the fund, but slow donations means slow progress. We are also looking at getting an AMA Field Improvement Grant to help with the expense though funds from this are limited. If we don't fill the cracks & slurry our runway in the next 12-24 months, it is estimated that the asphalt will be beyond repair. That's bad! If everyone donated their \$50 the last three years, the slurry would have already been done. ### IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR 2020

- FIRE EXTINGUISHERS ARE MANADORY AT THE FIELD. Please bring a fire extinguisher when you fly.
- WEAR YOUR CLUB BADGES AT THE FIELD.
- <u>CLUB MEMBERSHIP DUES</u>, <u>APPLICATION FORM</u>, <u>AND FAA REGRISTRATION NEED-ED</u>. Your 2020 Club Membership Dues must be paid prior to February 1st if you want to maintain your membership in the club and flying privileges. You can give your payment to the Ethan Marsh, Club Secretary, pay on the website, so send a check (not cash) to CIRCLE CITY FLYERS, P.O. BOX 78732, CORONA, CA 92877. Please fill out and submitted your application form with any updated information. Don't for to include your AMA and FAA Registration Number. Once you pay your membership dues you will receive the new gate lock combination for 2020.
- <u>SLURRY FUND</u>. If you haven't paid your Slurry Fund Donation of \$100 then please do so. The Slurry Fund was initiated in 2018 and some members <u>have not contributed to it yet or have not paid the full amount</u>. You can pay on GoFundMe website, or give your check to a club officer, or mail it to CIRCLE CITY FLYERS, P.O. BOX 78732, CORONA, CA 92877. The monies collected will be used to slurry the runway which is estimated to cost between \$6k to \$7k. We need to make the repairs now before we find ourselves without a runway! It was reported that only 6 out of 62 members have paid the full \$100 amount.
- <u>CLUB MEETINGS</u>. Our club meetings are the 3rd Saturday of the month and held at the field. Meeting time is 11AM and it usually lasts for 1 hour. Most of the time we have a small raffle. ### HELPFUL FIELD AND CLUB HINTS WHILE AT THE FIELD

- Obey all AMA and Club Safety Rules.
- In case of fire at the field, call 911 immediately. If fire crews appear, either by truck and/or by air, immediately cease flying and ground your aircraft. All emergency responders, fire and law enforcement, are given priority to combat any and all threats that endanger life, property and the safety of individuals. Please do your best to assist and not be part of the problem.



- All members are required to have an ABC Fire Extinguisher at the field when they
  fly located in the pit area. Fly safe and be safe. Bring a First Aid Kit as added protection.
- Our field is in an area populated by wildlife including snakes. Please be aware of this
  danger and act accordingly when walking in the brush.
- Please pickup your trash before leaving the field and dispose of it in trash containers
  or if needed take it home with you.
- Fly with a buddy! Sometimes having an extra set of hands and eyes are helpful.
